DES MOINES WOODTURNERS MEETING (AAW Chapter meeting) - Saturday, December 12th,1:00 p.m., at the Woodsmith Store, 10320 Hickman Road, Clive, IA.

Basic Principles of Vessel Design - Rob Wallace will present a general review of turned vessel design, which



will include bowls, platters, open and closed vessels, and hollow forms. This presentation will help woodturners gain a better understanding of various important aspects of proportion, scale, and other characteristics of design having to do with producing visually-pleasing forms. The concepts of using faired curves, "lift", rim and foot treatments, and interpretation of overall form with a focus on learning how to improve your turnings. Being able to critique your work as you are turning, with an eye to achieving an aesthetically-satisfying piece is a skill all woodturners should develop. Examples of differently shaped forms will be used to develop basic skills for evaluating turned objects. In addition to learning to critique your in-progress work, by using a few pre-turned pieces mounted on the lathe, we will "fix" several common problems encountered by beginning and established woodturners, and show how these forms can be easily improved. This demonstration will allow you to get a different perspective on how to assess and critique your woodturned items, and enhance your turning skills and sense of design.


