The **Des Moines Woodturners** is an AAW Chapter serving central Iowa woodturners of all skill levels. The organization promotes continual education, inter-member networking, monthly meetings and a variety of other learning opportunities. Programs are presented to expose members to a wide variety of woodturning disciplines and promote woodturning safety. Membership is open to all individuals who have an interest in any aspect of woodturning and who are willing to share their experiences and knowledge with others.

Meetings are held at 1 p.m. the second Saturday of the month from September through May.

#### **MEMBER NETWORKING**

One of the hidden benefits of belonging to a woodturning chapter is getting to know other woodturners who have the same interests as you. Need help in solving a woodturning project? No doubt a fellow member would help by sharing their experiences on a similar project along with other helpful hints on tool use. That's why member networking is such a powerful benefit!! We've recently added a second monthly meeting specifically to facilitate member networking. It's held at the Maytag Scout Center from 9:30 to 11:00 on the 4<sup>th</sup> Wednesday of the month all year long. See web site for more information.

#### **EDUCATION**

Monthly meetings are designed to provide an educational experience for attendees. A featured demonstrator provides detailed information on a project or woodturning discipline each month. Members are encouraged to bring in examples of their work, a new tool, jig or fixture to share with the group at each meetings Show 'N' Tell.

#### ANNUAL DUES

NEW MEMBER annual dues are \$25.00. New members can join at any time. All dues expire on the January meeting date annually and are subject to change each calendar year.

NEW MEMBERS joining between Sept and Dec will have membership privileges the remainder of that calendar year PLUS all 12 months of the following year. Join Early!!

Dues provide members with monthly meetings from September through May, a membership card for discounts at participating stores, a monthly meeting bulletin, access to woodturning training classes and all library books and videos. You also get discounted rates at chapter sponsored woodturning events.

Annual RENEWAL memberships are \$5 less than NEW member dues providing renewal dues are paid no-later-than the expiration date shown on a current membership card.

### **EXPERIENCE LEVEL**

Beginner - A wannabe or actually getting started and buying woodturning equipment, tools and sharpening accessories. You're still learning a lot, turning simple projects and you have lots of questions you need help answering. Be sure to contact our Education Chair before buying any of your equipment and tools for advice. It will save you money!!!!!! For instance, woodturning tool sets ARE NOT recommended.

Intermediate - You have a shop and the essential quality and style of woodturning related tools and sharpening system for your interests. You've had training and adequate turning experience to use your tools safely and properly to feel comfortable turning spindle and cross grain projects and do so to stay reasonably proficient. You have a full sharpening system and a broad range of lathe tools and accessories

<u>Advanced</u> - You use nearly all your tools on a regular basis and you turn a wide variety of turning styles and types. You're familiar with a wide variety of specialty turnings and embellishments. You stay safe and proficient with all tools because of frequent, proper use.

## TERMS OF MEMBERSHIP

- must be age 18 or older
- complete & sign application for membership
- agree to uphold the purposes of the "Chapter"
- payment of annual "Chapter" membership dues as advertised for appropriate time period.

The board may revoke membership if in the opinion of the Board, the member:

- no longer supports the purposes of the "Chapter",
- fails to practice good safety at any "Chapter" event,
- fails to pay monies owed to the "Chapter" for a period of 30 days or more.

Failure to renew annual membership dues within 30 days of expiration will be cause to terminate membership and require any future membership to be as a New Member at New Member dues rate.
