DES MOINES WOODTURNERS HELP CHICAGO ARCHITECTURAL DISPLAY

Our Chapter President Dick Meuler was contacted by an architect based in London, England in June with a request that our chapter help prepare four "bowls" for an architectural display during the Chicago Architecture Biennial 2017. The initial information provided by the architect stated that the four bowls were going to be used in a collection of 40 bowls to make a column in the architectural exhibit. Each bowl was about 17 -19 inches in diameter and 6 -8 inches thick.

After many email communications about constructing these large pieces, our chapter agreed to provide a total of six bowls that varied in diameter from 9 to 15 inches that were 5 to 7 inches thick. Because these were architectural pieces, we were held to turning tolerances of 1/32 " on the diameter and the thickness of each piece. Will Zitterich, Tom Whalley, Mike Lustig, and Dick Meuler each turned pieces for the exhibit several of which are shown in the photos below.

Our chapter and each turner will be recognized during the exhibit in Chicago in September; we were selected in part because we are an AAW Chapter but also because of the willingness to serve on short notice and Dick Meuler's efforts to educate the architect about wood movement and the craft of woodturning.
