SECRETS OF BASKET ILLUSION REVEALED – Chapter Member Dave Rabe will be our featured January demonstrator to kick off the New Year.

We saw several of these forms at the Utah Woodturning Symposium in 2017. Later at the AAW Symposium in Kansas City, Harvey Meyer demonstrated the process. It was very fascinating and Dave decided to acquire the tools and dove in.

In this demo, Dave will follow Harvey's process. He will use various tools and techniques on the lathe to make a faux pattern platter. This will also involve the use of pyrography to make the radial lines. He'll go through the process step by step.

This technique was started by Lincoln Seitzman and then followed up by Jim Adkins, and David Nittmann. David gets credit for popularizing the embellishment. Harvey has several YouTube videos on the subject as well as Doug Schneider and Gord Rock to name a few.

Our Chapter Treasurer Tom Baker was the featured demonstrator at our December meeting with an excellent presentation on wood piercing. Tom introduced us to the tools including high speed dental drills (400,000 rpm) and moderate speed micromotors (40,000 rpm) and the bits and burrs that remove the wood. He shared patterns and transfer methods that one needs to get started on this method of embellishment. Following his experience as a woodturning instructor, Tom made us aware of the safety issues involved with piercing and gave us tips on personal protective gear for health and safety. A number of members stayed after the meeting for questions and follow-up with Tom.

If you were not able to attend the December demo, know that Tom improved his knowledge of piercing during his AAW Scholarship to the Arrowmont School in Gatlinburg, TN. He was fortunate to have attended the piercing class taught by J Paul Fennell and enjoyed a week of hands-on experience with one of the country's leading piercing woodturners

Be sure to let Tom know you appreciated his demo if you did not get a chance after the December meeting!.
