2018 FALL BASIC TRAINING CLASS COMPLETED

Saturday, October 20th marked the fourth and final lesson of the 17th Des Moines Woodturners class instructed by members Tom Baker, Dick Meuler, Tad Tadlock, Dave Yearian, and Director of Education Rob Beattie. Since the rebirth of the Chapter in 2013 as a non-profit entity, these instructors have had over 70 students attend woodturning technique classes.

This is the first class to take place in the new, spacious, well-lit and-designed warehouse space provided for Chapter training through the generosity of member Chuck Haas. The facility has enabled instructors to increase the class size from four to six students, thereby reducing the waiting list for DMWT members wanting to develop their skills. The next class will take place in late winter/early spring next year.

Chapter member Del Kramersmeier presented a live demonstration of turning finials. After a quick bio of his past, Del explained the various finial elements and how the size and placement of those elements effect the look and feel of the final piece. Del then demonstrated his technique of starting near the tail stock to form the top of the finial and slowly and gently working his way toward the headstock to form the base. The result was a very pleasing gradual shape similar in style to that of Cindy Drozda. Great Job Del. Thanks for traveling all the way from Eagle Grove to share your incredible talent to the Chapter.
