REGISTRATION DEADLINES

For DMWT Members – members have first priority and reduced fees when attending our sponsored seminars and workshops. Due to Cindy's airline reservation scheduling, hands-on workshop registrations, with full payment, must be received

no later than March 30th. All registration forms with payment, will be date/time stamped and preferred date slots will be filled based on the date/time received. Once a workshop day is filled, you'll have the opportunity to fill slots on other dates with openings or be placed on a standby list in case of a cancellation.

If we have less than 7 students registered for Tuesday, May 7th, DMWT reserves the right to cancel the workshop, return registration fees, and schedule Cindy for an earlier departure date.

NON-DMWT members – Non-members may submit their registration and payment in full for seminars and workshops. Workshop registrations will be date stamped and held until April 1st. Workshop checks will not be processed until applicant has been assigned a workshop. If workshops are filled, uncashed checks will be returned.

<u>FINAL CUT-OFF DATE</u> – All registrations for Saturday seminar & possible late call to fill a workshop cancellation, must be rec'd on or before April 30th.

<u>CANCELLATIONS</u> – If you cancel your workshop date and there is someone on a standby list willing to replace you, your Workshop fee will be refunded. If no one is available to replace you, your registration fee cannot be refunded. Seminar cancellations are refundable up to April 15th.

ABOUT CINDY DROZDA - Cindy Drozda, Boulder Colorado, has worked with wood professionally since age 19. She has been turning since 1985. Her elegant lidded vessels with delicate finials bring a contemporary flair to classic forms. Her work can be seen at the finest juried shows and exhibitions in the USA, as well as in several books. Cindy shares her woodturning knowledge and passion as an international demonstrator, teacher, writer, and producer of instructional DVDs. She has been invited to teach in Canada, Great Britain, Ireland, Australia, and at symposia and clubs across the US. Before choosing woodturning as a career Cindy worked as a cabinet maker, rebuilt airplanes, and made hang gliding equipment.

I've heard it said that Cindy is a "petite powerhouse of talent and teaching."

Any who have attended Cindy's sessions at AAW National or other regional symposiums, admire her ability to relate to her audience and workshop students. She excels at teaching and illustrating concepts so students "catch on" to the techniques she covers. Much of Cindy's work also incorporates burls, which she is skilled at figuring out how to turn.

Using multiple centers, a triangular shape is created on the lathe. Along this one-day journey, you will learn some valuable tips and techniques that can be applied to many of your future projects. A lunch, break snacks and drinks are included in the fee. Seminar to be held at the Woodsmith Store.
