BASIC WOODTURNING CLASS GRADS

Last week two more students completed the Chapter's Basic Woodturning class in record time. Class was held on a Monday and Friday of the same week leaving students only three days to complete their basic spindle turning homework. It consisted of turning eighteen total projects; six shoulder cut, six cove cut and six bead cut spindles as illustrated below. Class work also includes turning an egg, Christmas Tree ornament and a lidded box. The class teaches the fundamentals of woodturning and the proper use and control of the Spindle Roughing Gouge, Parting tool and Spindle Gouge. BASIC BOWL TURNING CLASSES FINALIZED

Ten members are participating in a one-day Basic Bowl turning class in five sessions limited to two students per class under our Covid protocol. Classes will be held in October and November during weekdays. The class covers basic information on harvesting turning wood, what forms to get out of the various parts of a tree, creating bowl blanks and easy ways to round out square or octagonal bowl blanks. The class covers the tool cutting rules that change when shaping bowls versus spindles and emphasizes the spindle turning tools that must NEVER be used when turning cross grain bowls. Various bowl blank mounting methods are also covered. Each step of mounting and turning a bowl will be demonstrated and students will then repeat those steps on their individually assigned Jet 1221 VS lathe. Class fee is \$15, and students will sign a liability release. These classes are full for 2020.

TAKE A CHAPTER TAUGHT WOODTURNING CLASS

Our Chapter Training Center is located in donated space in the Valley Junction area of West Des Moines and is equipped with ten Jet 1221 variable speed lathes and a Wolverine Sharpening System with 8" CBN wheels. Under normal times, we taught classes with up to eight students. Under Covid 19 rules and practicality, we have tried to limit classes to two students. We also provide any wood needed for our two Basic classes, but not for homework. Students are required to provide their own High-Speed Steel tools, that meet safety standards, along with an ANSI Z87+ rated face shield and assorted accessories outlined in class material. Students should own or have easy access to a lathe and reasonable HSS tool sharpening system as tools need sharpening often (within minutes, not days). Most basic classes also require use of a scroll chuck to hold work. We have had requests for specialty classes and may squeeze in project or technique one day classes as requested by members where we can have a minimum of two students during Covid rule times. You can sign-up for Basic classes, but all names go on a waiting list in the order the requests are received. Requests for other specialty or technique classes are always welcomed.
